GROUP WORK PRACTICUM AND FORCE FIELD REVIEW

Participants work as a member of an experiential training group using the group process as the basis for learning the method and techniques of systems-centered practice. Taking up group membership involves learning boundarying, subgrouping, vectoring and conceptualizing in the phases of group development.

The objectives of this training are as follows:

- To introduce an innovative approach which enables therapists to understand the dynamics of both individuals and groups from a common (systems) perspective.
- To learn to use functional subgrouping to recognize and integrate differences instead of ignoring or scapegoating them.
- To learn the “fork-in-the-road” technique which encourages patients to explore their impulses, emotions and conflicts instead of acting them out or explaining them away.
- To work with a specific sequence of defense modifications that reduce the restraints to therapeutic change and automatically release the drive towards survival, development and transformation of all living human systems (the person, member, subgroup and group-as-a-whole).
